In the Name of God Amen. I Jane Colebatch  
of Ditton Priory in the County of Salop Spinster  
being of good sound and disposing mind and memory  
praised be Almighty God for the same Do make this  
my last Will and Testament in manner following.  
I give devise and bequeath unto my kinsman the  
Reverend Joseph Ball of Ditton Priory aforesaid and  
his Son Timothy Ball All my Real Estate in the  
parish of Clebury Mortimer in the said County of  
Salop To hold to them the said Joseph Ball  
their Heirs and Assigns for ever as Joint Tenants  
and all the rest ~~the~~ residue and remainder of  
my Real and Personal Estate of what Nature or  
kind soever or wheresoever I give devise and bequeath  
unto ~~my~~ them the said Joseph Ball and Timothy Ball  
to be equally divided between them Share and Share  
alike - And Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute  
and appoint the said Joseph Ball and Timothy  
Ball joint Executors of this my Will hereby  
revoking all former Wills by me made - In  
Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand &  
Seal this Ninth day of November in the Year of our  
Said one Thousand seven hundred and eighty six
